※1 “Student in exceptional circumstances”: Student whose provider of educational expenses passed away or the student/provider suffered from natural disasters within six months before starting the semester\*.  
(\* For newly-enrolled student, within one year before the university enrollment.)

※2 For following students, there is a case where “full exemption of the tuition fee” are approved.

- Those who are Japanese undergraduate student and in tax-exempt household.
- Those who receive grant type scholarship from Japan Student Services Organization.

※3 For students who suffered from natural disasters such as The Great East Japan Earthquake, Kumamoto Earthquake, The Heavy Rain Event of July 2018 of The Hokkaido Eastern Iburi Earthquake, there is a case where they can apply for the enrollment/tuition fee exemption.

### 【Students who cannot apply for Enrollment Fee Exemption/Deferment and Tuition Fee Exemption】

If any of the following cases are applicable to you, you cannot apply for the enrollment fee exemption/deferment and the tuition fee exemption.

- Those who have already paid the enrollment/tuition fee.
- Those who work at a company, government office or school and others, and received a subsidy from those organizations as the enrollment/tuition fee.
- Scholarship students or government-sponsored international students who receive the scholarship or a subsidy as the enrollment/tuition fee.
