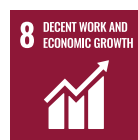

After graduating from Kyoto University School of Agriculture in 2003, I worked KUBOTA Corporation as researcher. In 2007, I joined KANSAI TLO (New name: TLO KYOTO) which is subsidiary of Kyoto University, Technology Transfer Office, and serve as CEO (2013-2018). From 2017, concurrently in charge of the Industry-Academia Collaboration Division of Kyoto University; in 2018, established Kyoto University Original Co., Ltd. and served as its director (-2020). From 2020, I am Professor/Academic Research and Industrial Collaboration Management Office (Now: Open Innovation Platform) of Kyushu University, and Vice president of Kyushu University (in charge of industry-academia-government collaboration and intellectual property) from Oct 2020.

More than 20 years have passed since the challenge of commercialising university research results began in Japan. Universities are now expected to be a source of innovation and the centre of the ecosystem. This seminar will introduce the Open Innovation Platform which is the industry-academia collaboration organisation of Kyushu University and its activities for the commercialisation of research results.
