Application Guidelines for Poster Presentations

June, 2022

1. Purpose

Kyushu University Institute for Asian and Oceanian Studies is aiming to create a new academic field that will open the future by contributing to the resolution of social issues in Asian and Oceanian countries through both solutions to the problems of today and prediction of the issues expected to be faced tomorrow.

"Kyushu University Asia Week * 2022" will be held from November 4th (Friday) to November 12th (Saturday), 2022. As one of the related programs, Poster Presentations for young researchers, graduate students, and undergraduate students who are responsible for the Asia and Oceania research in the future will be held. We are hoping that the poster presentation will become an active deliberation opportunity for discovering and encouraging innovative research. We look forward to your entries.

※Kyushu University Asia Week

Kyushu University is located in Fukuoka, the city which has prospered as Japan's gateway to continental Asia from ancient times. In light of Fukuoka's geographical and historical characteristics, Kyushu University has made a focus on Asia a part of its mission since it was founded, and the University has a long history of collaboration with Asian universities. Based on our achievement in Asia-related studies as well as our expertise on Asia, Kyushu University has promoted further interactions with universities and other institutions in Asia.

2. Details of Application Process

We accept all research fields related to Asia and Oceania. Research on Asia and Oceania can be conducted in any field, method, or target country, but we strongly recommend research that contributes to the realization of the SDGs (United Nations Sustainable Development Goals).

[Eligibility and Requirements]

- (1) Young researchers in Kyushu University within 8 years after the acquisition of his/her Ph.D. as of April 1, 2022*(Faculty Members and Post-doctoral Fellows)
- (2) Graduate Students, Undergraduate Students (Regardless of age)
* Period(s) of childcare leave, etc. (prenatal/postpartum leave, childcare leave) are exempted from the 8 years

[Number of Awards]

- (1) Grand Award: 1 person
- (2) Excellence Award: 2 persons (will be given in two categories: 1 young researcher and 1 graduate / undergraduate student.)
- (3) Special Award: 2 persons (will be given in two categories: 1 young researcher and 1 graduate / undergraduate student.)

[Details of the Award]

Expense for Research and Further Education will be supported according to the award rank (Grand Award: 100,000 JPY, Excellence Award: 50,000 JPY, Special Award: 30,000 JPY). This expense cannot be carried over to the next fiscal year.

Young Researchers will allocate this expense to the recipients themselves, and the Graduate School and Undergraduate Students will allocate it to the laboratory to which the recipients belong, as of April 1, 2022.

Please comply with the University's regulations and manage the expense appropriately (in the case of the Graduate Student and Undergraduate Students, please execute it under the control and supervision of the laboratory). In case of graduate /undergraduate students are not affiliated with a laboratory, the IQ Office will manage the transaction for expenses.

3. Application Procedure

(1) Application Deadline: **5: 00 p.m. Friday, September 30, 2022**

(2) Research Proposals (form1) must be submitted through the administrative office of the applicant's department. Please make the file name "Affiliation_Your Name" or "Affiliation_Job title_Your Name".

4. Selection Process

Selection will be made in two stages. In the first stage, the Asian and Oceanian Award Selection Committee will screen applications and select 10 to 20 finalists. In the second stage, poster presentations will be made during Asia Week 2022, and the award ceremony will be held in the latter half of Asia Week 2022.

The method of the poster presentation will be announced at the time of notification of the first selection results.

Announcement of the first-round results: Friday, October 14th

Poster data submission deadline: Tuesday, November 1st

Poster presentation: Monday, November 7th

Award Ceremony: Friday, November 11th

*Note: The above schedule is subject to change due to the circumstances.

5. Report on Research Achievements

Recipient researchers must report on the progress and results of their research by the due date (to be announced by IQ office). The expense report of graduate /undergraduate students should be prepared by the administrative staff of the department.

6. Others

The posters or presentation videos of the finalists will be posted on the website of Q-AOS.

In addition, awardees are strongly encouraged to participate in the activities of Q-AOS (such as exhibitions, seminars, and symposiums) to make the research findings publicly available.
