

## Financial Allowance

### 1. Outline

Financial Allowance is the funds provided to the students of this program, regardless of the student's financial situation. Its purpose is to allow students to concentrate on their studies and research.

### 2. Eligibility

Financial allowance is paid to students who fulfill all the following requirements-

- (1) Students who attend the program continuously.
- (2) Students who are not Research Fellows (DC) of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS).
- (3) Students who don't receive scholarship from the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO)
- (4) Students who are not recipients of a MEXT scholarship.
- (5) International students who are not receiving scholarship from the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) or scholarship from their countries.
- (6) Students who are not receiving any other support, except for tuition fee allowance.
- (7) Students who are not employed, except for the following.
  1. Teaching Assistants or Research Assistants at Kyushu University
  2. Clinical Fellows at Kyushu University Hospital or Center for Advanced Medical Innovation (Only based on Kyushu University 2004 Regulation no.147)
  3. Part time lecturers at a university (universities, junior colleges, or technical colleges)
  4. Supporters of conference research (Not regular)
  5. Teaching Assistants of research activities at a high school, such as representatives at a super science high school
  6. Any work recognized as required research for the students of this program (Only in cases where students submit their application along with a written explanation )

※ Please note that students have to pay their taxes themselves.

※ Financial Allowance will be provided as a subsidy from the Japanese government until March, 2020. After March, 2020 a monthly 100,000 yen will be provided.
