## **Infection Prevention Measures**

#### Maintaining an infection-resistant environment

#### **Practicing social distancing**



 Requiring mandatory face masks and seating arrangements that consider social distancing in classrooms, cafeterias, and other locations.



- Limiting the number of passengers in elevators at one time and making sure staircases move in a single direction.

- Enhancement of the "Bus-Stop-Queue Visualization System" to avoid congestion on commuter buses.

#### Disinfection, Sanitization & Anti-Virus Measures



- Regular disinfection and cleaning of classrooms and other locations.
- Installation of cleaning materials such as disinfectant wipes in classrooms and other locations.



- Installation of circulators and anti-virus filters in air conditioning units for better ventilation of classrooms.

### **Installation of Temperature Screening Locations**



- Installation of temperature screening locations at places where students gather, namely libraries and dormitories.
- Installation of non-contact temperature measurement devices.
