

Outline of exemption system and application eligibility for international student

※ “Student in exceptional circumstances”: Student whose provider of educational expenses passed away or the student/provider suffered from natural disasters within six months before starting the semester*.
(* For newly-enrolled student, within one year before the university enrollment.)

【Students who cannot apply for Enrollment Fee Exemption/Deferment and Tuition Fee Exemption】

If any of the following cases are applicable to you, you cannot apply for enrollment fee exemption (deferment) and tuition fee exemption.

- Those who have already paid the enrollment/tuition fee.
- Those who work at a company, government office or school and others, and received a subsidy from those organizations as the enrollment (tuition) fee.
- Scholarship students or government-sponsored international students who receive the scholarship or a subsidy as the enrollment (tuition) fee.
- Scholarship foundation (organization) does not allow you to receive exemption from the university.
