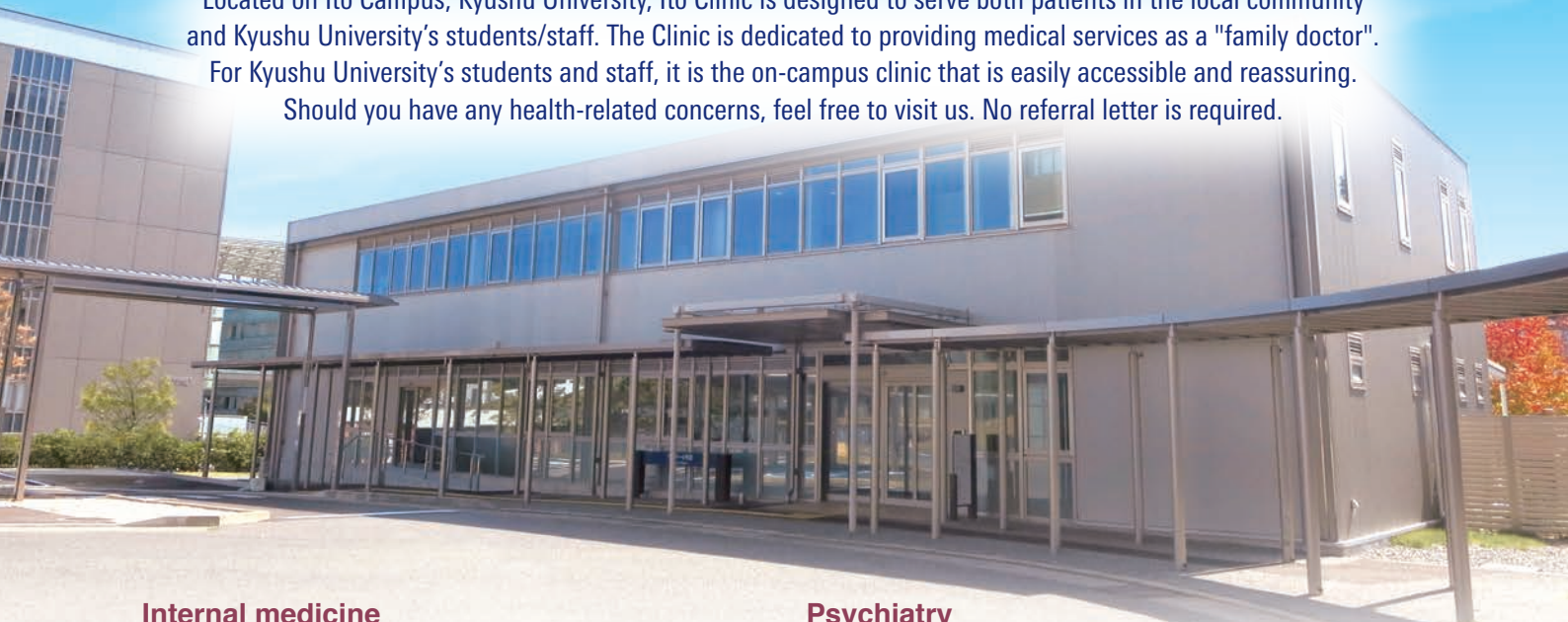


Kyushu University Ito Clinic

Internal medicine

- common problems in internal medicine such as cold, stomachache, vomit, diarrhea, rash, etc
- chronic diseases such as high blood pressure, diabetes, hyperlipemia and hyperuricemia
- medication for allergic rhinitis, asthma, constipation, etc
- vaccination (influenza, meningococcus, etc)

Psychiatry

- headache, malaise, loss of appetite, etc due to stress and sleep disorders
- common mental diseases such as adjustment disorder, depression, anxiety disorder

When you don't bring a valid insurance card, you will have to pay the full amount for your treatment

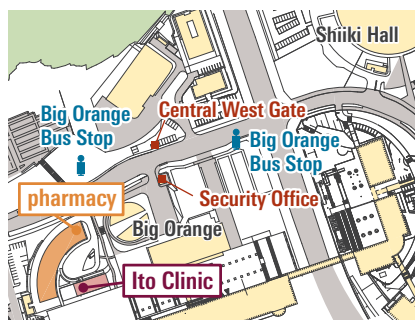
📖 "Okusuri-techo", a book keeping your prescription records (if you have one)

【Common testing items】

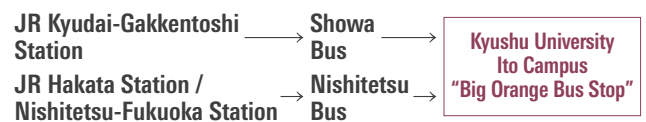
- Blood test •ECG examination •X-ray inspection
