Selected from among current faculty members of the Education and Research Council who are not serving as council members, vice presidents, or vice council members, these individuals possess extensive knowledge and experience in the academic departments and graduate schools responsible for the university's core mission of education and research. To ensure that the selection does not result in bias toward specific campuses or academic fields, and while taking into account the number of members in each department and the number of council members, two members were selected from the humanities and social sciences, two from the sciences and engineering, two from the medical sciences, and one from research institutes or equivalent organizations through a voting process.
