Notice Regarding Applications for Enrollment Fee Exemptions (Deferment) and Tuition Exemptions for the Fall Semester of 2026

Student Support Division, Kyushu University

For students who enrolled (or transferred) in 2026 and wish to apply for the University's original system of enrollment fee exemption (deferment) and tuition fee exemption, please carefully check the information below before submitting your application

★First, please confirm that you meet the eligibility requirements below★

Eligibility Requirements

***Applicants who do not satisfy the respective requirements cannot apply for the university's original system.**

• Enrollment Fee Exemption (October entrants only; advance application required) • Tuition Fee Exemption

Student who do not satisfy the eligibility requirements for the “New System for Support of Higher Education (including tuition-free education for large families)” but fall under the special circumstances described at

[Special Circumstances] Within one year prior to enrollment ^{Note 1}, the person primarily responsible for covering educational expenses (hereinafter referred to as the “financial supporter”) ^{Note 2} has died, or the student or the person responsible for educational expenses has suffered a natural disaster such as a flood or storm, resulting in is deemed to be significantly difficult

Note 1) “Within one year prior to enrollment” refers to

for April enrollment: April 1, Reiwa 7 (2025) to March 31, Reiwa 8 (2026) and

for October enrollment, from October 1, Reiwa 7 (2025) to September 30, Reiwa 8 (2026).

Note 2) The person responsible for covering the international student's tuition and other expenses must be the student themselves or a parent or guardian residing in Japan. Parents or guardians residing in the student's home country are not eligible.

• Deferment of Enrollment Fee (October entrants only; advance application required)

Applicants who satisfy the following criteria:

- Students who are unable to pay the enrollment fee during the enrollment process due to a delay in the transfer of a scholarship or educational loan equivalent to the enrollment fee amount.

1. If you wish to apply for an enrollment fee exemption or tuition fee exemption

- For those requesting an enrollment fee exemption:

Please do not pay the enrollment fee during the enrollment process; instead, submit the advance application form.

- For those wishing to apply for a fee exemption:

Please contact the Financial Support Section in advance via email (e-mail: gagmenijo@jimu.kyushu-u.ac.jp).

Please contact us well in advance to ensure you meet the application deadline.

Afterward, please submit your application via the exemption application system during the application period listed below.

[Exemption Application Periods]

Students Enrolling in April: (1st Step) August 5 – September 14 (until 23:59, Japan Time)

(2nd Step) August 5 – September 15 (excluding August 10–14, weekends, and holidays)

Students Enrolling in October: (1st Step) October 5 – October 15 (until 23:59, Japan Time)

(2nd Step) October 5 – October 16 (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays)

2. If you wish to deferment of the enrollment fee

***You do not need to apply into the exemption application system**

1. Check Your Eligibility

Please verify whether you meet the eligibility requirements.

2. Submission of “Provisional Application” [at the enrollment procedure]

Do not pay the admission fee during the enrollment process; **instead, submit a pre-application***.

*Please submit the “**Provisional Application for Enrollment Fee Deferment (Exemption)**” to the relevant office.

3. Submission of Application for Deferment of Enrollment Fee and required Documents

In early October, the Financial Aid Office will send an email to your primary student email address regarding the submission of the application for deferral of the admission fee and documents proving that you meet the criteria for special circumstances. Please submit the required documents by the deadline.

***If you do not submit the documents by the deadline, or if the submitted documents do not demonstrate that you meet the criteria for special circumstances, your application for deferral will be treated as withdrawn; please pay the admission fee promptly. A late payment fee will be charged if the admission fee is paid after the specified deadline.**

4. Notification of Selection Results...Around mid-November

(1) Results will be notified via the “Message for You” section of the Student Portal System or sent to your student email address.

No notifications will be sent by mail or to parents.

(2) We cannot accept appeals regarding selection results based on comparisons with other applicants or past results.

5. Payment of the enrollment Fee Following Notification of Selection Results

Please **pay the amount indicated in the notification by the due date.**

[Payment Method]

(1) Please transfer the enrollment fee to the University’s enrollment fee account specified in the selection results notification.

• If your request for deferment of the enrollment fee is denied, payment must be made within **20 days** of receiving the notification of results.

If deferment of the enrollment fee is granted, payment is due by **the end of January**.

[Registration for Tuition Transfer Account]

Account registration must be completed via online. Applicants for tuition exemption must also register.

Students enrolling in October 2026 must complete registration between **October 7 and 31**.
